

RESOLUTION # 18-021

RESOLUTION ALLOWING NON-ESSENTIAL COUNTY OFFICES TO CLOSE ON
December 24, 2018

WHEREAS, NRS 245.040 and NRS 252.050, allow a County office to deviate from the hours of operation if the Board of County Commissioners provides written approval, if the deviation will not conflict with the election law of this State and if the deviation is fiscally neutral or will result in cost savings;

WHEREAS, the closure of County offices on the 24th of December, 2018 will not conflict with the election laws of this State;

WHEREAS, the 24th of December, 2018 historically has presented County office with few visitors because of the holiday and;

WHEREAS, the closure of County offices on the 24th day of December, 2018 would reduce the costs of building operations such as heating and lighting;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Mineral County, Nevada, a political subdivision of the State of Nevada hereby resolves to permit County offices to close on Monday, December 24, 2018. Such closure shall not include essential operations personnel such as those in the Sheriff's Office, Fire Department/emergency personnel or Road Maintenance crews in the event of snow or other emergencies. Such closure shall not create a countywide holiday, nor entitle holiday pay to those retained to work but merely permits County offices to close when they otherwise would not be entitled to close. Employees shall have the option to work, to take available accumulated leave, but not accumulated sick leave, or to take leave without pay.


This Resolution shall be effective upon passage and approval.
